5. What demands of discipleship does Jesus lay upon people in Luke 14:25-33? As you reflect on these, what areas in your life do you need to give over to the Lord?
6. How does this statement by Michael J. Wilkins in his book, “Following the Master” shape your perspective on discipleship? *Discipleship is, therefore, not one thing that I do; rather, discipleship summarizes all the activities of my personal, family, and church life. Personally, I see myself as a disciple of Jesus above all else. I see my responsibilities in my family as promoting mutual discipleship. And I see discipleship not as one program of the church, but as summarizing the goal of the church.*
7. What are some practical ways you can approach life as discipleship with the lost, your family, friends, work colleagues, and other members of the church?
