Application of Matthew 28:16-20

- 1. Discipleship is in the home, at work, and it is **the** ministry of the church. How can you be more intentional in these contexts and the relationships the Lord has given you to "make disciples?"
- 2. Do you have an attitude to go? Do your prayers, your financial decisions, and your time management reflect this attitude?
- 3. Is there something you need to stop doing or start doing to be more deliberate in making disciples?
- 4. How clearly are you able to articulate the Gospel? Feel free to use the 4 R's (Reverence, Rejected, Redemption, Response) as a template. Begin memorizing Bible verses that teach Gospel truths.
- 5. This week pray for unbelievers you know, asking the Lord to save them and for opportunities you might have to share the Gospel with them
- 6. You could also study and pray for the unreached in other parts of the world through a ministry like HeartCry Missionary Society or a resource like <u>www.joshuaproject.net</u>
- 7. What opportunities exist for you to teach others (informally and formally, through actions and words) to observe all that the Lord has commanded?
- 8. This week encourage a fellow believer e.g. ask them how you can pray for them (and then pray), comment on something they do/say that bears witness of their walk with the Lord, ask how they are doing (and listen).

<u>Reading this week:</u> In two weeks I plan on starting a series through Colossians. Get familiar with this book ahead of time by reading it through multiple times.
