## **Application of Colossians 2:16-19**

- 1. How would you define legalism? What legalistic practices sometimes exist in the modern church today? Including: food and drinks or special days?
- 2. Are you finding yourself under judgement or condemnation from others for some of your behaviour over what are 'grey areas'? If so, in what ways is v. 16 an encouragement?
- Do you hold to any form of judgement of people over grey areas? See Rom 14 (also 1 Cor 8; 10:23-30) for Paul's discussion on how to lovingly relate with other believers who differ on some matters of theology and practice.
- 4. Some people demand the church observe Saturday as the Sabbath with a day of rest and for worship.
  - a. How does this passage refer to the Sabbath?
  - b. What passage in Scripture describes the early church worshiping on a Sunday ("the first day of the week")?
  - c. What do Rom 14:5 and Gal 4:10-11 imply about the Sabbath?
  - d. Where is the command in the NT to keep the Sabbath?
- 5. What type of 'religious/spiritual experiences' do people in the modern church elevate above God's Word?
  - a. What does v. 18 say about those who promote their experiences as being a level of spiritual maturity unattainable by 'normal' Christians?
- 6. Where is genuine spiritual growth found? How are you pursuing Christ for spiritual growth?
- 7. While the false teachers were promoting legalism and experientialism as a 'supplement' to Christ and therefore turning the Colossians away from Christ, what can you do this week to encourage believers **toward** Christ?
