Application of Colossians 2:6-7

1. Study the Lordship of Christ as a means to deepen your understanding of this doctrine, but also to further apply this truth in your life. Verses include: Matt 28:18; Luke 1:43; 2:11; John 14:15; 20:28; Rom 10:9; Phil 2:9-11
2. The first command/imperative in this book is “walk in Him.” What does it mean to ‘walk in Christ’ and what is the significance of this being a command?
3. While God is ultimately building us up and establishing/strengthening us in faith, what can we do to be built up and strengthened?
4. Does “just as you were taught” point us back to what God has already revealed in Scripture or to some new form of teaching? How does this relate to the importance of knowing Scripture and spending time in His Word?
5. Why might an attitude of thanksgiving be such a repeated theme in Colossians (see Col 1:3, 12; 3:15, 16, 17; 4:2) as Paul is writing against the false teaching that is threatening the church?
6. Meditate on other verses on thanksgiving (e.g. 1 Chron 16:34; Pss 69:30; 100:1-5; Eph 5:20; Phil 4:6; 1 Thess 5:18). Spend time to thank the Lord throughout the week for what He has done and ask Him to help you live with an increasing attitude of thanksgiving.

Reading this week: Read through Col 2:1-7 this week as a recap of the last two weeks. Read Rom 1:16-17 in preparation for Vance’s sermon next week.
