Colossians 3:5-7

Christian Living: Killing Sin

Worldliness is to be Killed (v. 5a)
Worldliness is Listed (v. 5b)
Worldliness will be Judged (v. 6)
Worldliness is in the Past (v. 7)

Application of Colossians 3:5-7

- 1. What type of attitude does "put to death" suggest believers are to have toward sin?
- 2. Rather than just an attitude against sin, it's important to have a growing fear of the Lord and commitment to holiness, because this will develop a greater conviction to "kill sin."
 - a. Such conviction will come through knowing and applying God's Word (e.g. Ps 119:11; Deut 17:18-20).
 - b. You may also choose to specifically study the holiness of God and the fear of the Lord.
- 3. Do you struggle with sexual sin of any form (adultery, pornography, lust, self-gratification, homosexuality etc)?
 - a. What measures will you take to "put to death" these sins?
 - b. Are your 'boundaries' for what you watch and read putting sin to death or flirting with danger?
 - c. Do you need to seek counselling, accountability, support?
- 4. Look up other passages that refer to sexual sin and consider how we are to respond to such sin and the severity of it e.g. Matt 5:27-30; Rom 1:24-27; 1 Cor 6:9-11, 13, 18; 10:8; Eph 5:3-6; 1 Thess 4:3-8; Rev 21:8
- 5. In what ways can you proactively teach your children about sexual sin and protect them from society's perverted view? How can you disciple them towards a godly relationship/marriage?
- 6. Why is greed/covetousness considered idolatry? How does this definition challenge your view on the sin of greed?
- 7. What are the two reasons in vv. 6-7 that Paul describes as to why believers should not practice the sins he listed in v. 5?
- 8. Thank God that He has freed you from enslavement to sin and that although you used to live in sin, His forgiveness has removed all condemnation from your life (Rom 8:1)
