Application of 1 Tim 1:18-20

- 1. What ministry/spiritual gift/role of service has been entrusted to you? When challenges arise, how can you be encouraged by Paul's encouragement to Timothy?
- 2. Notice the personal and warm address Paul uses for Timothy, "my child" as he encourages him to persevere. How does this provide an example for us to encourage others in ministry?
- 3. Who and how can you encourage someone for their service in the church? Aim to encourage at least one person this week.
- 4. What attitudes and actions are involved in "keeping faith and a good conscience"?
- 5. What's the relationship between disobeying one's conscience and false teaching (see also vv. 5-7)
- 6. Thank God for your conscience as an internal warning system to keep you following His path. Ask Him to continually refine and sharpen your conscience in line with His Word.
- 7. Think about the following ways (you might think of more) to help protect our faith so we don't end up "shipwrecked" and consider how to include these in your life: church membership; accountability partners; daily time with the Lord in His Word and prayer; regular confession of sin; seek to love and obey Christ, not just learn about Him
- 8. How does Paul explain here (see also 1 Cor 5:1-5; 2 Thess 3:14-15) that the purpose of church discipline is restoration, not simply judgement? What are other benefits of church discipline?

<u>Reading this week:</u> Read chapter 1 of 1 Timothy this week as a summary of our study in this chapter. Read chapter 2 to become more familiar with the next chapter we'll look at.
