Application of 1 Tim 2:5-7

1. Consider the necessity of a mediator between God and men i.e. the differences and impossible gap to bridge (apart from a mediator), that exists between the sinless perfection of the creator and the sinfulness of the created.
2. Why was it necessary this mediator was "a man"? How does Paul (up to this point in the letter) also imply Jesus is God?
3. Upon reflection of both these previous points, take time to thank God for Christ as our mediator, the God-man.
4. Reflect on Christ's giving of Himself as a ransom for sin and the results this accomplished for believers (see e.g. John 10:17-18; Gal 1:3-5; 2:20; Eph 5:2, 25-27; Titus 2:14).
5. How does knowing Christ's ransom was effective to save you from sin strengthen your confidence in His work, the security of your salvation, and your eternal destiny?
6. How do vv. 5-6 provide us reasons for universal evangelistic prayer for "all kinds of people"?
7. Why does Paul seem to think it's important he emphasize his ministry to the Gentiles? Ask God to help you also preach and teach the Gospel to all types of people.
8. Pray for unbelievers to be saved each day this week (and I'd encourage you to do so every day of every week)
