

Caution in the Kingdom (Matthew 18:7-10)

1. The Appeal to Caution (v.7) - What does it mean to be a stumbling block? (Tempt one to sin)

1. To entice one to sin
2. To cause a person to begin to distrust and desert one whom he ought to trust and obey
3. To cause offense since one who stumbles or whose foot gets entangled feels annoyed

2. The Application of Caution (v.8-9) - Putting Off & Putting On:

Ephesians 4:22-32

Colossians 3:1-17

3. The Affection for Caution (v.10) - Ways in which we can be stumbling blocks for those around us:

1. Direct Temptation
2. Indirect Temptation
3. Sinful example
4. Failing to lead them to righteousness

Key Application: How you treat God's people is how you treat Jesus Christ.
