Application of 1 Timothy 3:14-16

- 1. Reflect on the blessing of Paul's letter (which he wrote because he wasn't in Ephesus) and how this truth has now been preserved and given to us as part of God's inspired Word. Thank God for using ordinary events and challenges to leave us with His truth for our benefit thousands of years later.
- 2. What increased weight of responsibility in how you and the church conduct themselves, comes from understanding the church is the house of God and the church of the living God?
- 3. How does recognizing you are part of the church, which is the pillar and support of the truth motivate and/or challenge you in your commitment to know and stand for the truth?
- 4. Reflect on and respond with prayer and praise for the great mystery of godliness, which is Christ Himself
 - a. He came in the flesh (see also John 1:1, 14; Phil 2:5-8; Heb 2:17; 1 John 3:5, 8b)
 - b. He rose from the dead proving His deity, His sinless perfection, His justification of sinners, His power over sin, death, and the devil (see also Rom 1:3-4; Rom 4:23-25; 1 Cor 15:54-57; Heb 2:14)
 - c. He was taken up in glory and is now seated at the right hand of the Father (see also Acts 1:9; Eph 1:20-23; Heb 12:1-2)
 - d. He is
 - i. the object of our preaching (e.g. Acts 8:5; 2 Cor 4:5) and
 - ii. the object of our belief (Acts 16:31; John 1:12; 3:16, 18, 36; 6:35, 40; 7:38-39; 11:25; 12:46) 1 John 3:23),
 - iii. because salvation is in Christ and Christ alone for everyone who believes (e.g. Rom 1:16; John 3:16; Acts 4:12)
- 5. Ask God to give you opportunity and boldness this week to confess Christ and stand for His truth

Reading this week: Read 1 Tim 3:14-16 and 4:1-5 ahead of next week.
