## **Application of 1 Timothy 5:17-18**

- 1. What does it mean and not mean for elders to "lead" (see also 1 Tim 3:4-5, 12; Acts 20:28-31; Rom 12:8; 1 Thess 5:12-13; Heb 13:7, 17; 1 Pet 5:2-3)?
- 2. What does it mean for an elder to "lead **well**"? How does this relate to elders who aren't leading "well"?
- 3. What does "double honour" mean?
  - a. According to our passage, which elders are eligible to receive financial recognition for their ministry efforts?
  - b. Do you have an attitude of "double honour" toward elders (whether from GBC or other churches)?
- 4. Apart from this passage, what's the biblical support for paying pastors? Consider other passages in the NT that refer to paying pastors (e.g. Matt 10:9-10, Luke 10:7; 1 Cor 9:1-14; Gal 6:6)
- 5. What is the responsibility and expectation upon those who preach and teach in the church and why? (see also Col 1:28-29; 1 Thess 5:12-13; 1 Tim 4:10)
- 6. What's the significance of Paul quoting from both the OT and NT and referring to them both as "Scripture"?
- 7. Hermeneutics: In what way can Paul apply a command in the OT regarding the treatment of oxen, to church leadership in the NT?
- 8. How do Paul's quotes from "Scripture" and his hermeneutic help you understand how to apply God's Word in your own life and circumstances?
- 9. Why is giving elders who lead well "double honour" important?
  - a. How will the church's approach to honouring their elders have direct impact on the members of the congregation and even be a witness to the community?
