## **Application of the Message for Evangelism**

- 1. How does the Bible explain the origin and value of humanity?
  - a. How does the Bible provide hope and truth for issues of racism, gender identity, gender equality, abortion, and euthanasia?
- 2. Reflect on and memorize Ps 139:13-15
  - a. Ask God to give you an opportunity to tell an unbeliever about Him as it relates to the truth in this passage (and that this would lead into a fuller Gospel conversation)
  - b. How does this passage personally encourage you as it relates to God's design for your body?
- 3. Having been created by God we're also accountable to God. What responsibility does this truth place upon every person?
  - a. How does rejecting the truth that God created us attempt to escape accountability to God?
- 4. Why is it important unbelievers are told they're guilty before God?
  - a. What verses in Scripture describe unbelievers as totally corrupt and both unable and unwilling to please God?
- 5. Why do all those outside Christ deserve eternal punishment?
  - a. What verses in Scripture explain what hell is?
- 6. How would you answer someone's question about 'how can a loving God send people to hell forever'?
- 7. How would you respond to someone who says they'll go to heaven if they're a "good person" (or by some other works-based means)?
- 8. Why can't people save themselves?
  - a. What Scriptures teach salvation is by faith, NOT works?
- 9. Memorize some verses about who man is that would be helpful to explain to an unbeliever in the context of evangelism.
- 10. Consider the reality of who you were before salvation (and even your continued struggle with sin) and respond in thanks to God for saving you, while you were yet a sinner! All glory be to our God!
