Application of "the Message for Evangelism"

1. What verses demonstrate Jesus is God?
 - a. Why was it necessary that Jesus be truly God if He's to save sinners?
 - b. How might you explain these truths to a JW or some other person who rejects the deity of Christ?
2. What verses demonstrate Jesus is Man?
 - a. Why was it necessary that Jesus be truly man if He's to save sinners?
3. How might you answer someone's questions about the Trinity, i.e. One God in Three Persons?
4. Why did Jesus need to live a perfect life and not just die a substitutionary death?
5. Reflect on the cost of Jesus' life for your sake, on your behalf, and for your sin (e.g. Isaiah 53; Rom 5:6-11; Phil 2:5-11; 1 Pet 2:21-25; and the Gospel accounts of His arrest, trials, and crucifixion).
6. What's the significance of Christ's resurrection and why is this an essential truth in the Gospel message (e.g. Rom 4:25; 1 Cor 15:12-20; 1 Pet 1:3)?
7. Reflect on the reality of who Christ is as it relates to your own salvation. Take time to thank and praise God for sending His Son to be your Saviour!
8. Memorize some verses that you could use when sharing the Gospel to explain who Christ is.
9. Pray for opportunities and courage to share the message of Christ to unbelievers this coming week.
