Application of the Message of Evangelism: God is

- 3. What questions could you ask someone about their view of God and what teaching could you provide to establish who God is?
- 4. How does the reality that everyone knows God exists (Rom 1:18-20) provide a helpful foundation in evangelizing someone, even if they say they don't believe God exists?
- 5. Because God is the creator of all He has authority over all, how does this truth place us under submission to God's commandments and His standard for holiness?
- 6. How are we to live because God is holy? How does reflecting on God's holiness lead us to strive for holiness?
- 7. How does God's justice provide comfort and confidence for you in how sin will be dealt with?
- 8. What does God's justice mean for an unbeliever?
 - a. Why is it important to describe God's justice with an unbeliever?
- 9. What are some ways in which God is compassionate?
 - a. How would you answer an unbeliever claiming God is not compassionate if He sends people to hell forever?
- 10. Ask God for opportunities (and boldness, love, wisdom) to share with unbelievers who God is this week.
- 11. Praise and thank God for who He is as you reflect on Him as it relates to the message of the Gospel and your salvation.
