Application of the Message of Evangelism: God is

1. Why is it important to start with God and focus the Gospel message on God, not man?
 - a. Why is getting the message of the Gospel correct so important?
2. Memorize some key verses about God and consider how these might be used in a Gospel presentation.
3. What questions could you ask someone about their view of God and what teaching could you provide to establish who God is?
4. How does the reality that everyone knows God exists (Rom 1:18-20) provide a helpful foundation in evangelizing someone, even if they say they don't believe God exists?
5. Because God is the creator of all He has authority over all, how does this truth place us under submission to God's commandments and His standard for holiness?
6. How are we to live because God is holy? How does reflecting on God's holiness lead us to strive for holiness?
7. How does God's justice provide comfort and confidence for you in how sin will be dealt with?
8. What does God's justice mean for an unbeliever?
 - a. Why is it important to describe God's justice with an unbeliever?
9. What are some ways in which God is compassionate?
 - a. How would you answer an unbeliever claiming God is not compassionate if He sends people to hell forever?
10. Ask God for opportunities (and boldness, love, wisdom) to share with unbelievers who God is this week.
11. Praise and thank God for who He is as you reflect on Him as it relates to the message of the Gospel and your salvation.
