Application of the Method of Evangelism

1. In what way is the method(s) of evangelism determined by the message for evangelism?
2. Who can you pray for to be saved (commit to pray for at least 2 people daily)?
3. Who can you be praying for (e.g. spouse, missionaries, friends), so they might have open doors and boldness to preach the Gospel?
4. Take an honest assessment of your life (e.g. words, deeds, attitude, habits) and consider areas of growth you would like to commit to growing in.
 - a. How can you grow in this?
 - b. What might you need to put off (sin) and put on (biblical truth, godliness)
5. How can you incorporate God into your natural and regular conversations with people?
6. What questions could you ask that would lead to Gospel conversations?
7. Who are some people in your "field" you could try and move the conversation toward the Gospel or more intentionally "chat your faith" with?
 - a. Do you recognize the sovereignty of God to place you in unbelievers' lives to share the Gospel (even if you meet them once)?
8. Prayerfully ask God for the words to speak, the boldness to speak and opportunities to preach the Gospel.
 - a. Repent of sin as needed in regard to evangelism (e.g. fear of man)
9. Are you available?
