Confidence in Yahweh during Crises

Yahweh is Eternal (v. 12a)

Yahweh is Personal (v. 12b)

Yahweh is Faithful (v. 12c)

Yahweh is Sovereign (v. 12d)

Yahweh is Immovable (v. 12e)

Yahweh is Holy (v. 13a)

Application of Habakkuk 1:12-13a

1. Why is Habakkuk a good model to follow when we might face some sort of crisis or have theological questions?
2. Why is knowing who God is the determining factor for our confidence (or lack of confidence) in Yahweh during crises?
3. Reflect on the eternity of God, see Gen 21:33; Ex 3:14; Deut 33:27; Ps 90:2; Is 40:28; 1 Tim 1:17; Rev 1:8
4. Reflect on the relationship we have with God as “my God” and the comfort and confidence that comes knowing God is personal.
5. Meditate on some of the promises of God in Scripture (e.g. Matt 6:33; John 3:16; 10:28-29; 14:1-3; Rom 8:28-29; 1 Cor 10:13; Eph 1:13-14; Heb 13:5) and thank God for His faithfulness to accomplish all He’s promised (even if sometimes it’s hard to see what He’s doing is moving in that direction).
6. What is the significance of understanding God to be “your rock” (see also Deut 32:4; 1 Sam 2:2; Pss 18:2, 31; 28:1)?
7. What does the word “holy” mean? Consider various passages in Scripture that teach about God’s holiness e.g. Ex 15:11; Lev 19:2; 1 Sam 2:2; Ps 5:4-5; 11:5; Prov 15:9; Is 6:1-5; 1 John 1:5; Rev 4:8.
 - a. How does God’s holiness give us confidence in Yahweh during crises?
8. How can you apply the truths of who God is to a crisis/challenge in your life now?
9. Are you guilty of assuming God’s going to answer your prayers a certain way? Ask God for forgiveness and help to trust Him, even when His plan isn’t your plan (Note: His is always better!)
