## **Application of Habakkuk 2:20**

- 1. How does knowing who God is and what He's done impact every aspect of your life?
  - a. How does this prompt you to study who God is and seek to understand God more through any reading of Scripture?
- 2. What are some of lies accepted today in society, in the church, in your life that lead you/people away from Christ to seek a counterfeit blessing?
  - a. What are the things you're seeking from idols that you need to repent of and replace with biblical truth?
- 3. Look at passages that describe the contrast between Yahweh and false gods and consider the greatness of Yahweh above all else (e.g. Deut 4:33-39; 1 Kings 18:17-40; Ps 115; Is 40:9-31; 44:1-20; Jer 10:1-16; Hos 13:1-4; 1 Cor 8:4)
- 4. Reflect on Yahweh's position as the enthroned king of all the earth (e.g. Ps 2:4; 11:4; 103:19; 115:3; 123:1; Is 6:1-5; Dan 4:37) and think on the significance of such truth for you personally and for the whole earth
- 5. In what way(s) will the unrighteous be silent before Yahweh?
- 6. In what way should the righteous be silent before Yahweh? How can embracing Yahweh's position in His holy temple comfort you when:
  - a. you're stressed, worried, & fearful about life and the future?
  - b. you're so focused on "doing" things (even if they're good)?
  - c. you (like Job and Habakkuk) have questions and doubts about or for God?
  - d. you're tempted to pursue a lie from the devil?
- 7. Meditate on Col 3:1-5 as we see the principle of looking up to the Lord enables us ("therefore" at the start of v. 5) to consider the old self as dead.
- 8. Memorise a verse to remind you Yahweh is enthroned above!
