Application of Habakkuk 3:1-2

1. This chapter is a congregational prayer/psalm/song written by Habakkuk, what value are public prayers/songs in your life (whether that's through the Psalms or prayers/songs of history)?
 - a. You might want to look up some prayers/songs from Scripture or church history and use them for your own prayers and personal worship.
2. How does hearing about Yahweh and from Yahweh through His Word make you respond? How should you respond?
 - a. Ask God to lead you to prayer when you're tempted to fear.
3. Rather than being self-focused on survival or success, Habakkuk's perspective changed to focus on God's plan and purpose,
 - a. What thoughts, words, actions reveal your perspective?
 - b. What do you need to learn from Scripture for God to change your perspective?
 - c. Are there areas of your life you've been questioning God or complaining to Him that you need to instead respond with prayer and faith?
 - d. In what **specific ways** can you seek the Lord to shift your focus from yourself to Yahweh?
4. Are you willing to pray for God's will and work to be done, for His glory, in your life, your family's life, our church, and our society, no matter what that might look like?
 - a. How can you thank God for trials in your life each day as you recognize His hand in them for your good and His glory?
5. What is the basis for Habakkuk's request that Yahweh would show compassion in His "rage, wrath?"
 - a. How can you pray this prayer for unbelievers?
