Application of Habakkuk 3:8-11

1. You might want to read Bob Kauflin's article(s) on singing about God's judgement and examples of songs he gives that reference this subject (<https://worshipmatters.com/2010/11/30/songs-that-reference-gods-judgments/>)
2. Consider other victory celebrations of God's wrath to judge the unrighteous and save His people e.g. Ex 15; Judges 5; Rev 19:1-5.
 - a. How do they teach you about who God is and what He does?
 - b. How are these instructive for your praise to God?
3. How does reflecting on God's power over nature comfort you and give you confidence in His power to control your circumstances and the future?
4. How does God's wrath and justice help you understand His mercy and grace?
5. As God fulfilled His Word to bring judgement upon the unrighteous (e.g. the wicked in Judah and wicked Babylonians), He will keep His promise to execute judgement in the future. You can trust Him!
 - a. Reflect on God's salvation and protection of His people in the past as a means to encourage you that He will do the same for you. What a faithful, loving God we serve!
6. You may wish to read (or at least skim through) God's future judgement upon the earth by His powerful hand with the force of nature in Rev 6-20.
7. What is the one principle of hermeneutics (the method for interpreting Scripture) mentioned that you must apply in your daily reading and study of God's Word? Why is this essential to understand Scripture?
 - a. Why is it important to correctly interpret the Bible?
8. Think on and Thank Christ! He is your deliverer, the divine warrior who conquered once for all the great power of sin and death and the ruler of this world through His death and resurrection. He who gave up His own life because of His love for you (Gal 2:20).
