Application of “Peace WITH God My Saviour”

1. How do people (inside and outside the church) often falsely present the bad relationship an unbeliever has with God?
 - a. How does a wrong view of this gap lead to an improper view of salvation, the depravity/sinfulness of man, and the holiness of God?
2. What is a biblical perspective on the relationship unbelievers have with God (see Gen 6:5; 8:21; Is 64:6; Matt 6:24; 7:11; 12:30a; Rom 3:10-18; 5:10; 8:7-8; Eph 2:1-3; 4:17-19; Col 1:21; Titus 1:15; 1 John 3:10)?
3. Consider also God’s wrath against unbelievers e.g. Rom 1:18; John 3:36; Ps 5:4-6; Ps 7:11
4. What is justification? How are we justified? When are we justified? See also <https://www.gotquestions.org/justification.html>
5. What’s the definition of “peace” as Paul is speaking to us from this passage? What does “Shalom” peace mean? How is this far more significant than simply the absence of conflict?
6. What’s the difference between objective “peace WITH God” (as in Rom 5:1) and the subjective “peace OF God” (as described in Phil 4:6-7)?
7. Consider God as the source of peace, recognizing we had no ability or intention to reconcile with Him (though we were fully to blame for our broken relationship), but that He initiated and achieved peace with us through His Son (see also Col 1:19-20)
8. How does objective peace WITH God lead a believer to inner peace (peace of mind) and horizontal peace (striving for peace with others)?
9. Are there broken relationships you have with others you need to do what you can to be at peace with them (Rom 12:18; Heb 12:14; Eph 2:12-17)?
10. Meditate on and memorize Phil 4:6-7, asking God to help you not be anxious for anything, but to lead you to prayerful trust in Him.
