 - c. What is the significance in recognizing Jesus as God's Prophet?
 - d. See for example, Deut 18:15, 18; Is 61:1; John 1:18; 12:49-50; Heb 1:1-3; and all Jesus' teaching
- 3. What is the role of a priest?
 - a. In what way did the OT speak of a future priest?
 - b. How did Jesus fulfil His role as God's anointed priest?
 - c. What is the significance in knowing Jesus as our High Priest?
 - d. See for example, Ps 110; Zech 6:12-13; Heb 5:5-10; 7:23-28; 9:11-14; 10:11-14
- 4. What is the role of a king?
 - a. In what way did the OT speak of a future king?
 - b. How did (and will) Jesus fulfil His role as God's anointed king?
 - c. What is the significance in understanding Jesus as God's King?
 - d. See for example, 2 Sam 7:8-16; Pss 2; 110; 132; Is 9:6-7; 11:1-5; Jer 23:5-6; Ezek 34:23-24; Hosea 3:5; Amos 9:11; Luke 1:32-33; Rev 1:5; 11:15.
- 5. What's the significance of Jesus being identified as the "son of David"? (see above in #4 and Acts 2:29–36; 13:22–23; 2 Tim 2:8; Rev 5:5; 22:16)
- 6. What's the significance of Jesus being identified as the "son of Abraham"? (see e.g. Gen 12:1-3; Rom 4; Gal 3)
- 7. Ask God to give you greater understanding of and love for Jesus as we work through Matthew's Gospel about Jesus.
