Application of Matt 3:13-17

- 1. Why did John try to prevent Jesus from being baptized?
 - a. How does this show the humility of John the Baptist?
 - b. Do you recognise your "need" to repent and your "need" for Jesus (and not just once, but consistently)?
- 2. Why did Jesus explain He needed to be baptized by John?
 - a. How does the text help define or reject some different views on what it means that John needed to baptize Jesus to "fulfill all righteousness"?
 - b. What are some suggested meanings of this phrase and is there a particular view you think is best? Why?
- 3. Why was it **necessary** for Jesus, the second member of the Godhead, to be anointed (empowered, strengthened, guided) by the Spirit for His life and ministry?
- 4. How does the Holy Spirit work in the life of believers today?
 - a. Ask God to fill you with His Spirit (Eph 5:18) and increase your dependence on the Spirit for a godly life and a fruitful ministry.
- 5. Read Psalm 2 and Isaiah 42, how do these passages address Jesus' role as King and Servant?
 - a. You may like to read further about the theme of "sonship" in the OT as it relates to the Messiah (e.g. 2 Sam 7:13-14; Is 7:14; 9:6-7) and the other three "servant songs" in Isaiah (49:1-6; 50:4-9; 52:13-53:12) to gain a greater understanding of these roles in the life and ministry of Jesus.
- 6. Look up the word translated "beloved" and reflect on the reality this is how God sees you if you're in Christ (cf. Rom 1:7)
- 7. While God delights in His children because He delights in His beloved Son, Jesus, what are ways we can "please" God? (see Rom 12:1-2; Phil 4:18; Col 3:20; Heb 11:5; 13:16, 20-21)
