## **Matthew 4:8-11**

Resolutions of an Overcomer (Part 3): I Will Worship God Only

Tempted to Worship another god (vv. 8-9)

Resolved to Worship God Only (v. 10)

The Outcome of Overcoming Temptation (v. 11)

## **Application of Matt 4:8-11**

- 1. What lies has society accepted to practice syncretism (combining more than one religious view or practice together) or polytheism (worshipping more than one god)?
- 2. What area(s) of weakness exist in your life that could be used as an attraction or appeal tempting you to sin e.g. popularity, power, prosperity, peace, pleasure.
  - a. Recognizing each person will struggle with different "attractive offers" how should this lead you to relate to people with struggles you don't face, but they do (see Gal 5:14-15; 6:2)?
- 3. How might you be tempted to take shortcuts (e.g. instant, cheap, without work) to achieve success or receive pleasure?
  - a. How would you explain the phrase, "right end, wrong means" as it relates to Jesus' temptation experience and yours?
- 4. Look up other passages that emphasize the command to worship God only e.g. Ex 20:3-5; Deut 6:13-15; Is 42:8; Matt 6:24.
- 5. Beyond physical idolatry, what's a broader definition of idolatry or worshiping another god?
  - a. Do you recognize all sin is a form of worshiping another god?
  - b. Do you understand 'idolatry' is a matter of the heart?
  - c. What other gods do you need to repent of worshiping?
- 6. What's the ministry of angels in a believer's life? See eg. Heb 1:14
- 7. Read Rom 7:15-25; Gal 5:16-18; James 1:14-15; 1 John 2:16 and consider the reality that though we're free from the power of sin (Rom 6:6-7), we still struggle with the remaining effects of sin.
  - a. How do these verses teach us we're responsible for our sin?
  - b. What do they teach you about the source of your temptation?
  - c. How does this help you overcome temptation?
