Application of Galatians 2:1-10

1. Read through the whole book of Galatians and summarize the main point of the book.
 - a. What's the context of the situation that prompted Paul to write Gal 2:1-10 and why is understanding this context important?
2. Reflect on the importance of Paul's meeting with the church leaders for the unity of the gospel and thank God for His united gospel.
 - a. Note: this is God's gospel. No person adds to it, takes from it, validates it or authorizes it!
3. Look up some key verses highlighting "the truth of the gospel" that teach salvation by grace through faith, not works e.g. John 3:16; Rom 3:28; 5:1; Eph 2:1-9; Titus 3:3-7
4. What are some false gospels, based on works, that are common today?
 - a. Why is such heresy contradictory and opposite God's gospel?
5. Do you judge other believers who are entrusted with the same gospel for how they proclaim this news?
 - a. Rejoice in God's work through His people to save the lost, even if we're different in many other ways (see also Phil 1:12-18)
6. Is God's grace given to you recognizable by family and friends, co-workers, strangers or does it hide behind your sin, selfishness and pride?
 - a. Ask God for His grace to shine forth, to break through in every area of your life so that the world may see and glorify God.
7. In what way(s) may you be able to "remember the poor"? Who are the poor in your life that you could help and how can you help them?
8. Meditate on the following verses in Galatians and praise God for Christ and the freedom we have in Christ (Gal 1:3-5; 2:16, 20; 3:6-7, 11, 13-14, 26-29; 4:4-7; 5:1, 5, 13, 18, 24; 6:15)!
9. Ask God for an opportunity this week to proclaim His gospel
