## **Application of Matt 4:23-25**

- 1. The world doesn't know who Jesus is, what do you know about Jesus from this passage?
  - a. Ask God for the opportunity this week to tell a non-believer who Jesus is.
- 2. What does Jesus' travelling throughout "all Galilee" inform us about His work ethic, His compassion on the people, and His servant heart?
  - a. His ministry also wasn't exclusive, discriminatory, or secret, how does this show us Jesus' care and compassion for people?
- 3. Why was Jesus' teaching and preaching different than other religious leaders? See Matt 7:28-29; 13:54; Mark 1:22; Luke 4:32; John 7:46
- 4. Because Jesus is the king, what relevance does that have on us (and all people) when we hear His Word?
  - a. In what ways do you demonstrate <u>and</u> not demonstrate a correct view of Jesus' authority in your life, especially in hearing His Word?
  - b. What are some practical ways you can increasingly think about and submit to Christ's authority?
- 5. Think about what life would be like if there was no sickness and disease, if there were no need for hospitals and medical staff, if the lame walked, the blind saw, and the deaf heard. This was what happened when Jesus healed "every kind of disease and every kind of sickness"
  - a. Note: what happened during Jesus' earthly ministry will also happen again (e.g. Isaiah 65:20; Rev 21:1-4; 22:3)! Meditate on this reality as encouragement for the hardships now and hope for the future.
- 6. How do Jesus' works affirm His kingship? See Matt 11:2-6 (cf. Isaiah 35:5-7; 61:1); John 3:2; 10:37-38; 20:30-31.
- 7. What type of Jesus follower are you? A disciple, a fan, a self-seeker?
