Application

Application of Matthew 5:8

- 1. What do the words "pure" and "heart" mean?
 - a. What verses point to the heart being the whole inner being?
 - b. To help understand what Jesus does mean, what does "purity in heart" **not** mean?
- 2. Look up examples of those who are pure in heart or are seeking purity in heart e.g. Ps 9:1; 19:14; 24:3-4; 26:2; 51:10; 57:7; 78:72; 2 Cor 5:21; Heb 4:15; 1 Peter 1:19; 2:22; 1 John 3:5
 - a. How can David and Jesus be examples for you to follow?
- 3. Reflect on passages that refer to us seeing God in the future e.g. Job 19:25-27; Ps 17:15; 1 John 3:2; Rev 22:3-4
 - a. What we'll see is beyond our imagination, but you may choose to look up descriptions in Scripture to help you partially imagine what seeing God will be like.
 - b. How does thinking about the truth of seeing God encourage you to live for the Lord today?
 - c. How does this truth put your current challenges and suffering into perspective?
- 4. Do you recognize your need for a pure heart or do you have a faulty understanding of yourself, sin, and God that leads you to think you're good enough?
 - a. You may choose to read Scripture addressing these areas of fault and to increase your understanding of these things.
- 5. Ask God for a pure heart. Ask Him for the desire to be purer in heart and to lead your will in making decisions to grow in such purity.
- 6. Are there things you to need to put off and avoid that aren't leading you toward purity of heart? E.g. inappropriate pictures/movies, people you're being negatively influenced by, other things that are idols in your life, sinful thoughts?
- 7. Those who are pure in heart love, meditate, memorize, and obey God's Word (Ps 119:9, 11) what's your view of the Bible and how can you grow in a correct view of God's Word?
